Greetings:

Here is an update on the Indigo Girls. They were awarded Gold records (sales of 500,000 units in the U.S.) for their Epic L.P. last week. The second single from the album is being released to radio on September 13th. It is "Land Of Canaan" (listen closely for a new guitar part). The video for the single was shot live at the Uptown Lounge in Athens, Georgia. A long form video of the entire show will be available for sale to the public in January.

"Strange Fire" will be released by Epic in October. The album is re-sequenced. "Blood & Fire" was deleted (it was essentially the same version as the Epic L.P. release) and a new cover of the Youngblood's song "Get Together" was added. This song will also be released by Atlantic Records on the soundtrack for the Wonder Years. The song will be featured in an episode of the TV show sometime next winter.

As for TV appearances, if you missed Amy and Emily this summer on Letterman, Sajak and E.T., you will have several chances to see them this Fall. They will appear on Letterman again, the David Sandborn show (Sunday night), Arsenio Hall and, hopefully, a well known live comedy show which airs on Saturday nights.



Thanks for all the letters and cool stuff we keep getting in the mail.... The word this month is (ready?)



P.S. Old album Strange Fire will be re-released soon!




HEY EVERYBODY!
