







A friend introduced me to his work - so I'm passing it on to you. I've been watching a lot of Peter

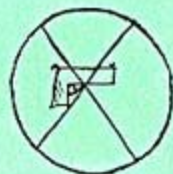
Greenaway Films. He has a new one out - I'll be seeing it this week.
